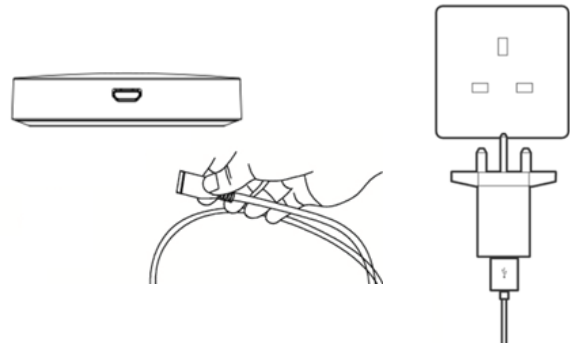

## Connecting to Mobile or Tablet

### WIFI Connection

1. Ensure your smart phone is connected to your home WIFI network.
2. Scan the QR code or search the "Smart Life" APP from Google Play store or Apple Store.
3. Install the Smart Life APP and register account.
4. If this is the first time to use the Smart Life APP then tap "Register" and register your account by following the on screen instructions.



3. Press the WIFI connection button on gateway and hold until the LED begins to flash quickly (2 per second).

4. Open the APP and press the "+" button on the upper right corner to add the device.
5. The App will then scan for nearby devices, if the hub is found follow the on screen instructions, if the hub is not found please follow the below steps, you may need to enter the hub into connection mode again, see step 3.
6. Press "Others", then press the "Connector Wi-Fi" icon and enter your WIFI password.
7. Select "Confirm indicator rapidly blink" and press 'Next'.
8. Wait a moment until the connection is complete.
